### Lesson Introduction

"Warning Against Antichrists" 1 John 2:18-27

The term **last hour** is used only here in the New Testament. It refers to the "last days" or the "end times"—the time between Christ's first and second comings (see Joel 2:28; Micah 4:1). The first-century readers of 1 John lived in the "last days," and so do believers today. The word **last** also gives a sense of urgency. Christ will return soon.





### Lesson Introduction

"Warning Against Antichrists" 1 John 2:18-27

From the earliest days of the church in and around Ephesus, false teachers had been a problem. When Paul bid his final farewell to the elders of the Ephesian church, he warned, "I know full well that false teachers, like vicious wolves, will come in among you" (Acts 20:29). These are merely precursors to the one Antichrist.





#### Lesson Introduction

"Warning Against Antichrists" 1 John 2:18-27

You have heard (referring to the teachings from the apostles) that the Antichrist is coming. (Paul wrote about this in <u>2 Thessalonians 2:3-10</u>.) John mentioned this not so that believers would try to identify the person, but so that they might be ready for anything that would threaten their faith. Besides, as John went on, already such persons who could fit that description have come on the scene—already many such antichrists have appeared.
