

INTRODUCTION

St Paul informs the Thessalonians how, being hindered himself from visiting them, he had sent Timothy to comfort them, of whom he gives a high character, vv. 1, 2. He also shows that trials and difficulties are unavoidable in the present state, vv. 3, 4.



INTRODUCTION

In this section, Paul mentions the joy he had on hearing by Timothy of their steadiness in the faith, for which he returns thanks to God; and prays earnestly for their increase, vv. 5-10. Paul prays also that God may afford him the opportunity to seeing them, v. 11. And that they may abound in love to God and one another and be unblameable in holiness at the coming of Christ, vv. 12, 13.
