<sup>1</sup>Beloved do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> By this you know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God,

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> and every spirit that does not confess [a]that Jesus [b]Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the *spirit* of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> They are of the world. Therefore they speak *as* of the world, and the world hears them.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.
