INTRODUCTION

Introduction

In the previous paragraph (1:9-11) Paul included a hard listing of sinful behaviors. But his reason was not for self-righteousness—pointing out other people's sins to make himself look better. In the face of our tendency to despair when confronted with our own sinfulness, Paul could cheerfully say, "Well, just look at how desperate I was, and what God's mercy has done for me!" Paul was convinced that if God could save him, then God could save anyone.





From the high point of praise to God, Paul turned his attention back to Timothy. The young disciple faced a difficult situation in the church at Ephesus, but Paul knew he could handle the challenge. What Timothy needed in the meantime was encouragement and helpful instructions. Like a coach preparing his eager young fighter for the match of his life, Paul put an imaginary arm around Timothy's shoulders and passed on a few lastminute instructions.
