
Scripture Reading



The style of using lengthy sentences continues from chapter 1 into this chapter, in which verses 1-7 are one sentence in the Greek.




To help understand the first seven verses, note that the subject of that Greek sentence is "God" (2:4) and that there are three main verbs:



- 1) "gave us life" (2:5),
- 2) "raised us from the dead" (2:6), and
- 3) "seated with"
  (2:6). The object of each of these verbs is "us," referring to believers. God has made us alive, raised us up, and seated us with Christ.










