Verses 1-6 are on unity; verses 7-16 are on diversity in the church. The challenges for churches today parallel the challenges that faced first-century churches like the one in Ephesus. We must remain *unified* as believers, incorporating our *diversity* so that we can serve and glorify our Lord.


