Unleashing the Holy Spirit

The Gospel group the Mighty Clouds of Joy recorded a song, "If the Lord Needs Somebody I'll Go." These lyrics reveal the receptivity and desire to do something great for God for His glory. We not only recognize this theme of readiness for servitude through this song, but it is also echoed through the origin of scripture in Isaiah 6. Isaiah 6 is recognized as the moment of Isaiah's conversion experience. Isaiah saw the Lord high and lifted up and His glory filled the earth. After this euphoric experience Isaiah made the statement "Here am I, send me."

This statement "Here am I" cited in scripture and song is commendable because it unashamedly says I am available to God!
